Planning Proposal – Manly Warringah War Memorial State Park

Northern Beaches Council requests that the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment provide a Gateway Determination for the attached Planning Proposal under Section 3.34 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The Planning Proposal seeks to amend provisions within the Warringah Local Environment Plan 2011 for certain land at Manly Warringah War Memorial State Park. The objective of the Planning Proposal is to amend the Warringah LEP 2011 with regard to three (3) Crown land lots (Lot 76 DP 504237, Lot 77 DP 504237 and Lot 2 DP 710023) to support a range of recreational land uses that are compatible with and protect the environmental, recreational, aesthetic and cultural values of the Manly Warringah War Memorial State Park.

Section 3.22 matters

Does the proposed instrument

- c) deal with matters that do not warrant compliance with the conditions precedent for the making of the instrument because they will not have any significant adverse impact on the environment or adjoining land?

(Note – the Minister (or Delegate) will need to form an Opinion under section 3.22(1)(c) of the Act in order for a matter in this category to proceed).

Notes

- Where a council responds 'yes' or can demonstrate that the matter is 'not relevant', in most cases, the council will be authorised to make the plan, as a matter of local planning significance
- Endorsed strategy means a regional strategy, sub-regional strategy, or any other local strategic planning document that is
 endorsed by the Planning Secretary of the Department.
