

Gateway Determination

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP_2016_WOOLL_003_00): to amend the Woollahra Local Environmental Plan 2014 to heritage list street sign inlays.

I, the Director, Metropolitan (CBD) at the Department Planning and Environment, as delegate of the Greater Sydney Commission, have determined under section 56(2) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* (EP&A Act) that an amendment to *Woollahra Local Environmental Plan 2014* to heritage list street sign inlays, should proceed subject to the following conditions:

1. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the EP&A Act as follows:
 - (a) the planning proposal is classified as routine as described in *A Guide to Preparing LEPs* (Department of Planning & Infrastructure 2013) and must be made publicly available for a minimum of **28 days**; and
 - (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of *A Guide to Preparing LEPs* (former Department of Planning & Infrastructure 2013).
2. Consultation is required under section 56(2)(d) of the EP&A Act with the:
 - Office of Environment and Heritage;
 - Roads and Maritime Services;
 - Sydney Water;
 - Telstra;
 - National Broadband Network Co Limited;
 - Optus;
 - Jemena, and
 - Ausgrid.

Agencies are to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material, and given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal.

3. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).



4. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be **9 months** from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.
