This planning proposal seeks to introduce mobile food vending vehicles (food trucks)as exempt development on Council-owned roads.

It is proposed to amend Sydney Local environmental Plan 2012, By inserting a new exempt category in Schedule 2 as follows:

Mobile food vending vehicles:

 (1) Must be located on Council-owned roads within existing lawful car parking spaces (excludes classified roads under the Roads Act 1993).
 (2) Must be operated in accordance with an approval under Section 68 of the Local Government Act 1993).

One of the key aims of OPEN Sydney is to<br>ensure that Sydney's night time economy achieves sustainable economic growth and<br>creates a variety of opportunities for multiple night-time experiences in Sydney.  |
