Lucas Heights Resource Recovery Park Planning Proposal Submission

Suez Recycling and Recovery Australia (formerly SITA Australia) is submitting the attached planning proposal to amend the *Sutherland Local Environmental Plan 2015* to allow for the expansion and modification of the existing Lucas Heights Resource Recovery Park. The planning proposal applies to parts of the following lots:

- Lot 101 DP 1009354
- Lot 3 DP 1032102
- Lot 2 DP 605077.

In parallel to this planning proposal, a State significant development application (SDD 14_6835) has been lodged with the Department of Planning and Environment. This application seeks approval for the expansion and modification of the existing Lucas Heights Resource Recovery Park and applies to the same land to which the planning proposal applies.

The project contained within the State significant development application is currently prohibited under the current zoning under the *Sutherland Local Environmental Plan 2015*. The planning proposal seeks to insert a new local provision to permit the proposed use of the land for a resource recovery park (waste or resource management facility as defined under the LEP).

The planning proposal should be read in conjunction with the environmental impact statement accompanying the State significant development application, which provides a detailed assessment of the potential impacts occurring on the land associated with the planning proposal.
