Alteration of Gateway Determination

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP_2015_LANEC_002_00)

I, the Executive Director, Regions at the Department of Planning and Environment as delegate of the Greater Sydney Commission, have determined under section 56(7) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* (the Act) to alter the Gateway determination dated 21 October 2015 (as altered) for the proposed amendment to the Lane Cove Local Environmental Plan 2009 as follows:

1. Delete:

condition 1(a): "Prior to undertaking public exhibition, the planning proposal is to be revised to:

(a) update the Economic Impact Assessment to include detailed urban design consideration of the proposed development in relation to the transition in height to surrounding development, and the minimisation of overshadowing, privacy, and view impacts."

and replace with:

a new condition 1(a): "Prior to undertaking public exhibition, the planning proposal is to be revised to:

(a) prepare an Urban Design Report to include detailed urban design consideration of the proposed development in relation to the transition in height to surrounding development, and the minimisation of overshadowing, privacy, and view impacts"
