I have determined as the delegate of the Minister, in accordance with section 3.34(7) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*, to alter the Gateway determination dated 25 September 2017 for PP_2017_LAKEM_003_00. The Gateway determination has been altered to amend condition 1 and the title and description of the proposal and provide additional time to complete the LEP amendment. The Alteration of the Gateway Determination is enclosed.

In making this decision I have noted the correspondence from both Office of Environment and Heritage and the NSW Rural Fire Service, additional site contamination investigation and proposed amendments to the Planning Proposal. I consider that Council has adequately resolved the matters identified in Condition 1 of the Gateway determination.
