Planning Proposal PP_2015_GLAKE_005 – Alteration of Gateway Determination

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP_2015_GLAKE_005)

I, Director Regions, Hunter and Central Coast at the Department of Planning and Environment as delegate of the Minister for Planning, have determined under section 56(7) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act")* to alter the Gateway determination dated 27 August 2015 (as since altered) for the proposed amendment to the *Great Lakes Local Environmental Plan 2014* as follows:
