Conclusion

In conclusion, the revision to the level of significance of Aboriginal sites on the Kylor land from moderate to low was justified by established professional practice exemplified by Bowdler, the degree of disturbance documented by me, the demonstrated lack of research potential and the changing state of knowledge as to the common occurrence of Aboriginal stone artefacts in the local landscape.
