Planning proposal to amend Wingecarribee Local Environmental Plan 2010

I am writing in response to your Council's letter dated 7 May 2013 requesting a Gateway determination under section 56 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") in respect of the planning proposal to permit a 'vehicle repair station' as an additional permitted use on land at 3482 Old Hume Highway, Berrima.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, I have now determined the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway determination.

While the proposal to include 'vehicle repair station' as an additional permitted use on land at Old Hume Highway, Berrima is supported, Council is encouraged to consider rezoning the site to an appropriately business or industrial zone which permits the intended land use, rather than permitting the use via additional permitted uses. If a suitable alternative zone is identified, Council is to amend the planning proposal accordingly prior to undertaking public exhibition.

The Minister delegated his plan making powers to councils in October 2012. It is noted that Council has now accepted this delegation, however has asked not to use its delegation for the making of this plan. I have considered the nature of Council's planning proposal and have decided to issue an authorisation for Council to exercise delegation to make this plan because the proposal is considered to be a matter of local significance.

Council may still need to obtain the Director General's agreement to satisfy the requirements of relevant S117 Directions. Council should ensure this occurs prior to the plan being made.

The amending Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 12 months of the week following the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request to draft and finalise the LEP should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's Office 6 weeks prior to the projected publication date. A copy of the request should be forwarded to the department for administrative purposes.

The State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under section 54(2)(d) of the EP&A Act if the time frames outlined in this determination are not met.

Gateway Determination

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP_2013_WINGE_007_00): to permit 'vehicle repair station' on land at Old Hume Highway, Berrima.

- I, the Executive Director, Rural and Regional Planning at the Department of Planning and Infrastructure as delegate of the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, have determined under section 56(2) of the EP&A Act that an amendment to the Wingecarribee Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2010 to permit a 'vehicle repair station' as an additional permitted use on land at 3482 Old Hume Highway, Berrima or alternatively, rezone the subject site to an appropriate business or industrial zone which permits vehicle repair stations should proceed subject to the following conditions:
- 1. Prior to undertaking public exhibition, Council is to update the planning proposal to confirm whether the proposal will only apply to those lots which have existing development associated with the Berrima Diesel Services constructed on them.
- 2. Additional information regarding the below matters is to be placed on public exhibition with the planning proposal:
 - flora and fauna
 - heritage
 - bushfire
 - water quality
 - noise

Once the above information has been obtained and prior to undertaking public exhibition, Council is to update its consideration of S117 Directions 1.5 Rural Lands, 2.1 Environment Protection Zones, 2.3 Heritage Conservation, 5.1 Implementation of Regional Strategies and 5.2 Sydney Water Drinking Catchments to reflect the outcomes of this work.

- 3. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") as follows:
 - the planning proposal must be made publicly available for a minimum of 28 days;
 and
 - (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of *A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning & Infrastructure 2013)*.
- 4. Consultation is required with the following public authorities under section 56(2)(d) of the EP&A Act and/or to comply with the requirements of relevant S117 Directions:
 - Office of Environment and Heritage
 - Sydney Catchment Authority
 - Hawkesbury-Nepean Catchment Management Authority
 - NSW Rural Fire Service (S117 Direction 4.4 Planning for Bushfire Protection)

Each public authority is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material, and given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal.

5. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it



may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).

6. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be **12 months** from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.
