Planning Proposal to amend the minimum lot size map for Lot 391 and rezone Lot 201 of the Farnborough Property, Moss Vale

Thank you for your letter dated 7 February 2013 inviting the Sydney Catchment Authority (SCA) to comment on the planning proposal to amend the minimum lot size map for Lot 391 and rezone Lot 201 of the Farnborough Property, Moss Vale. It is understood the outcomes of amendments to the Wingecarribee Local Environmental Plan 2010 would be:

- A variation to the current minimum lot size of 4000 square metres on Lot 391 to create 102 lots ranging in size from 1000 square metres up to 10,570 square metres.
- Adjusting the boundary between Lot 201 DP1095417 and Lot 40 263584 to create a B1 Neighbourhood Centre zone and RE1 Public Open Space zone.

Your letter to the SCA notes that the proposed subdivision on Lot 391 is intended to be serviced by reticulated sewer. The SLWCA outcomes for residential sewered development are therefore attached.

The SCA has no concerns with any part of the planning proposal. SLWCA outcomes for sewered residential development over Lot 391 show the proposal would be a low risk to water quality. A moderate risk is shown over the area of vegetation on the site, but it is noted that this is categorised as an endangered ecological community (EEC) under the Threatened Species Conservation Act 1995, and this patch will be retained as a single lot that will not be developed.

It is noted there are a number of dams on the site that will be retained within individual lots, making their management easier when the lots are eventually developed.

Further assessment will need to be undertaken at the development stage to ensure any proposed development has a neutral or beneficial effect on water quality.
