Planning proposal to amend the daft Shoalhaven Local Environmental Plan 2014

I am writing in response to your Council's letter dated 12 December 2013 requesting a Gateway determination under section 56 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") in respect of the planning proposal to rezone land within the 'Heritage Estates' and the adjoining 'Elouera and Fairview Estates' from RU2 Rural Landscape to E2 Environmental Conservation.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, I have now determined the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway determination.

The Minister delegated his plan making powers to councils in October 2012. It is noted that Council has requested to be issued with delegation for this planning proposal. I have considered the nature of Council's planning proposal and have decided to issue an authorisation for Council to exercise delegation to make this plan.

The amending Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 9 months of the week following the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request to draft and finalise the LEP should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's Office 6 weeks prior to the projected publication date. A copy of the request should be forwarded to the department for administrative purposes.

The State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under section 54(2)(d) of the EP&A Act if the time frames outlined in this determination are not met.

Gateway Determination

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP_2014_SHOAL_002_00): to rezone land within the 'Heritage Estates' and the adjoining 'Elouera and Fairview Estates'.

I, the Deputy Director General, Growth Planning and Delivery at the Department of Planning and Infrastructure as delegate of the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, have determined under section 56(2) of the EP&A Act that an amendment to the draft Shoalhaven Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2014 to rezone land within the 'Heritage Estates' and the adjoining 'Elouera and Fairview Estates' from RU2 Rural Landscape to E2 Environmental Conservation should proceed subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Prior to undertaking public exhibition, Council is to update the planning proposal to include existing and proposed land zoning maps, which are at an appropriate scale and clearly identify the subject lands. Council is to ensure all mapping is prepared in accordance with the Department's 'Standard technical requirements for LEP maps' prior to finalisation of the plan.
- 2. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") as follows:
 - (a) the planning proposal must be made publicly available for a minimum of **28 days**; and
 - (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning & Infrastructure 2013).
- 3. Consultation is required with the following public authorities under section 56(2)(d) of the EP&A Act and/or to comply with the requirements of relevant S117 Directions:
 - NSW Office of Water
 - Booderee National Park
 - South East Local Land Services
 - Office of Environment and Heritage
 - Office of Environment and Heritage, NSW National Parks and Wildlife Services
 - Commonwealth Department of Environment, National Reserve System

Each public authority is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material, and given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal.

4. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).



5. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be **9 months** from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.
