DRAFT PLANNING PROPOSAL: 65 BUTTENSHAW DRIVE, AUSTINMER

Council at its meeting of 25 July 2016 resolved to prepare a draft Planning Proposal for 65 Buttenshaw Drive, Austinmer.

Council resolved that:

- 1. A draft Planning Proposal be submitted to the NSW Department of Planning and Environment for 65 Buttenshaw Drive, Austinmer seeking a Gateway determination to:
 - a) Rezone part of the site from E3 Environmental Management to E4 Environmental Living, with a Floor Space Ratio of 0.3:1 and a minimum lot size of 999m2.
 - b) Reduce the minimum lot size of the remainder of the site from 39.99ha to 2,999m2 to facilitate the proposed boundary adjustment.
- 2. Should the Gateway determination result in progression of the Planning Proposal, consultation be undertaken with NSW Rural Fire Service.
- 3. The draft Planning Proposal be exhibited for 28 days (excluding the Christmas New Year period).

Council also resolved to request authority for the General Manager to exercise plan making delegations in accordance with Council's resolution of 26 November 2012.
