## Planning proposal to amend Bega Valley Local Environmental Plan 2013

I am writing in response to your Council's letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> September 2013 requesting a Gateway determination under section 56 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") in respect of the planning proposal to provide additional supply of medium density residential dwellings and tourist development opportunities.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, I have now determined the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway determination.

I have also agreed the planning proposal's inconsistencies with s117 Directions 1.2 Rural Zones and 1.5 Rural Lands are of minor significance. In respect to s117 Direction 4.4 Planning for Bushfire Protection Council has indicated it will consult with the NSW Rural Fire Service prior to community consultation. This will satisfy the requirements of this Direction. No further approval or referral is required in relation to these Directions while the planning proposal remains in its current form.

## **DELEGATED**

The Minister delegated his plan making powers to councils in October 2012. It is noted that Council has requested to be issued with delegation for this planning proposal. I have considered the nature of Council's planning proposal and have decided to issue an authorisation for Council to exercise delegation to make this plan.

The amending Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 9 months of the week following the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request to draft and finalise the LEP should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's Office 6 weeks prior to the projected publication date. A copy of the request should be forwarded to the Department for administrative purposes.

The State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under section 54(2)(d) of the EP&A Act if the time frames outlined in this determination are not met.

## **Gateway Determination**

**Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP\_2013\_BEGAV\_00\_00**: to provide additional supply of medium density residential dwellings and tourist accommodation opportunities.

- I, the Regional Director, Southern Regional Team at the Department of Planning and Infrastructure as delegate of the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, have determined under section 56(2) of the EP&A Act that an amendment to the Bega Valley Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2013 to provide additional supply of medium density residential dwellings and tourist accommodation opportunities should proceed subject to the following conditions:
- 1. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") as follows:
  - (a) the planning proposal is classified as low impact as described in A guide to preparing LEPs (Department of Planning & Infrastructure 2013) and must be made publicly available for a minimum of 28 days; and
  - (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of *A guide to preparing LEPs (Department of Planning & Infrastructure 2013)*.

Consultation is required with the:

- Office of Environment and Heritage;
- NSW Rural Fire Service; and
- Transport for NSW Roads and Maritime Services;

under section 56(2)(d) of the EP&A Act. Each agency is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material, and given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal.

2. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).



3. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be 9 months from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.
