Planning proposal PP_2018_WINGE_006_00 to permit a shop to operate from Lot 90 DP 751253, 18 Spring Street, Moss Vale.

I refer to your letter of 23 April 2018 in relation to planning proposal PP_2018_WINGE_006_00 to amend schedule 1 of Wingecarribee Local Environmental Plan 2010 to permit a shop to operate from Lot 90 DP 751253, 18 Spring Street, Moss Vale.

As delegate of the Minister of Planning, I have now determined the Planning Proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway determination. I have considered Council's request for delegation to make the plan and this is supported.

The amending Local Environment Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within nine months of the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible.

The State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under Section 3.32(2)(d) of the Act if the timeframes outlined in this determination are not met.
