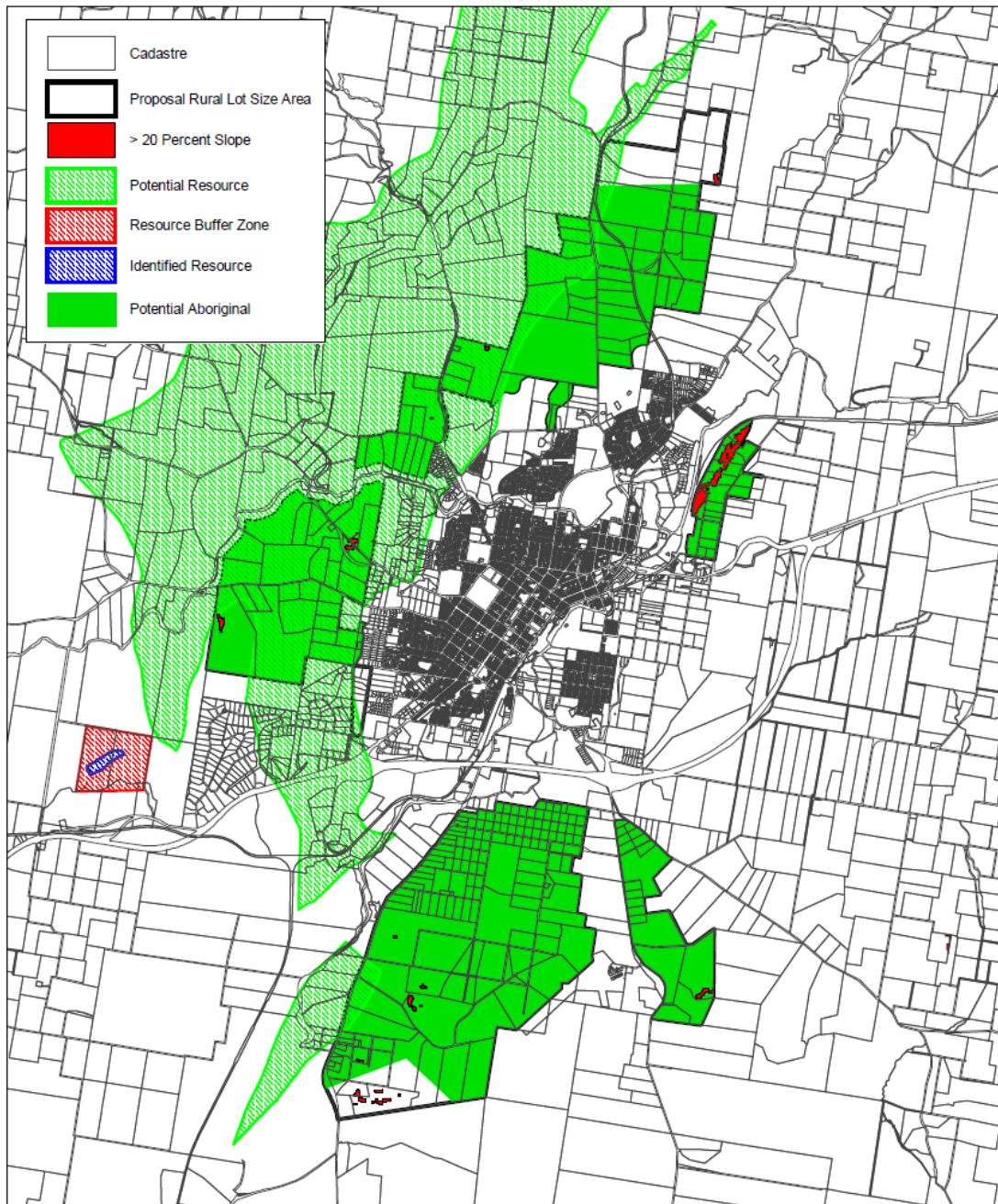


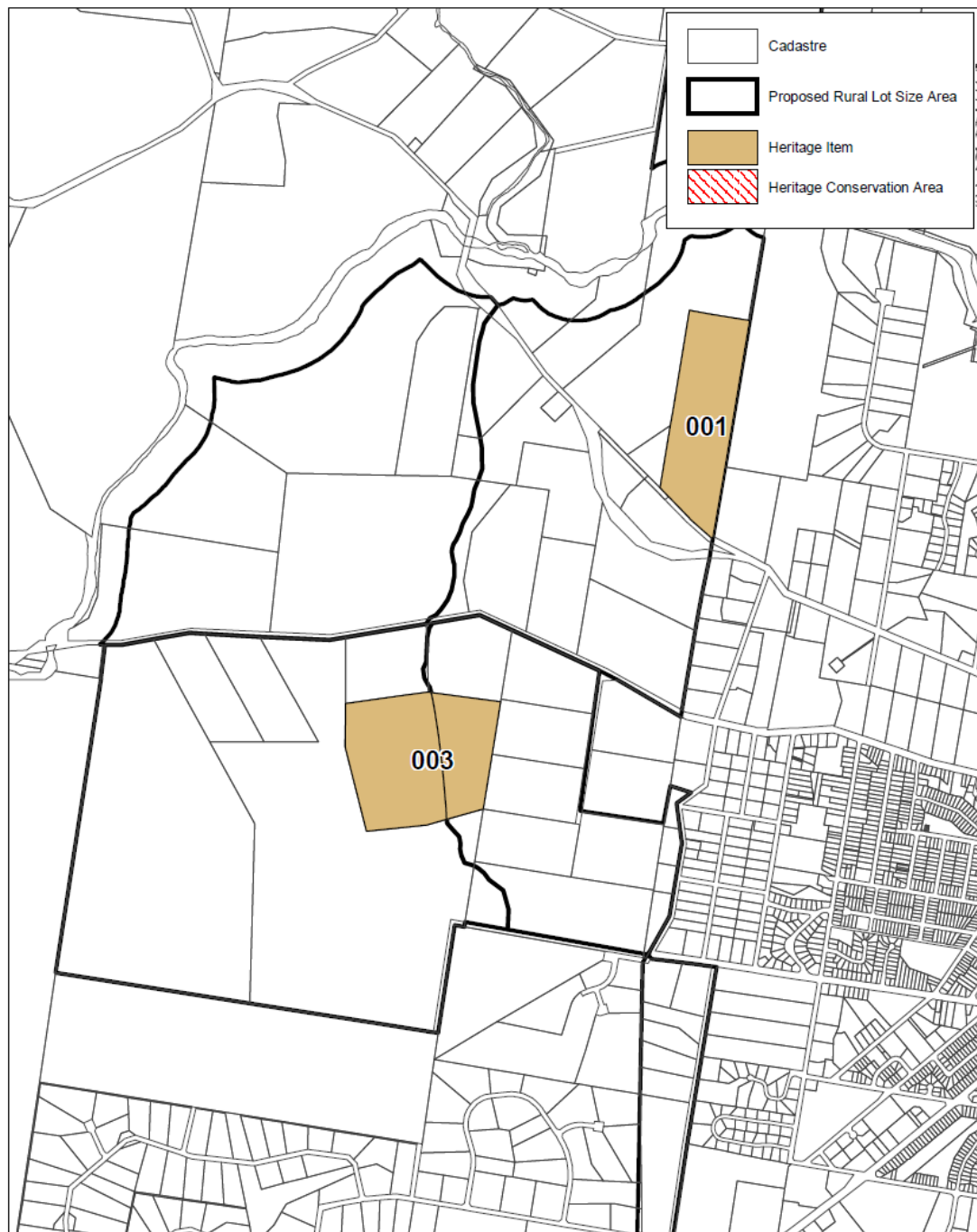
- (ii) Slope (>20%), potential mineral resource areas and potential Aboriginal artefacts areas are shown on figure 8.26.

Figure 8.27 (C) Heritage Map - Goulburn

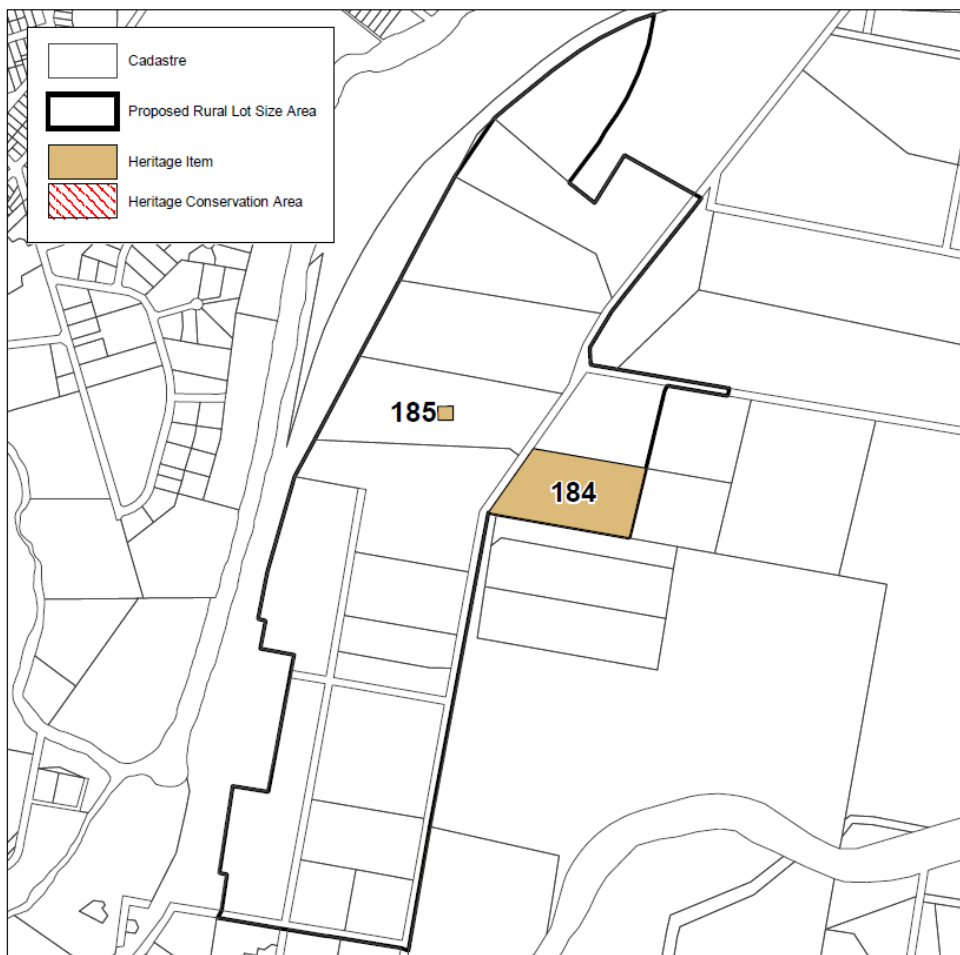
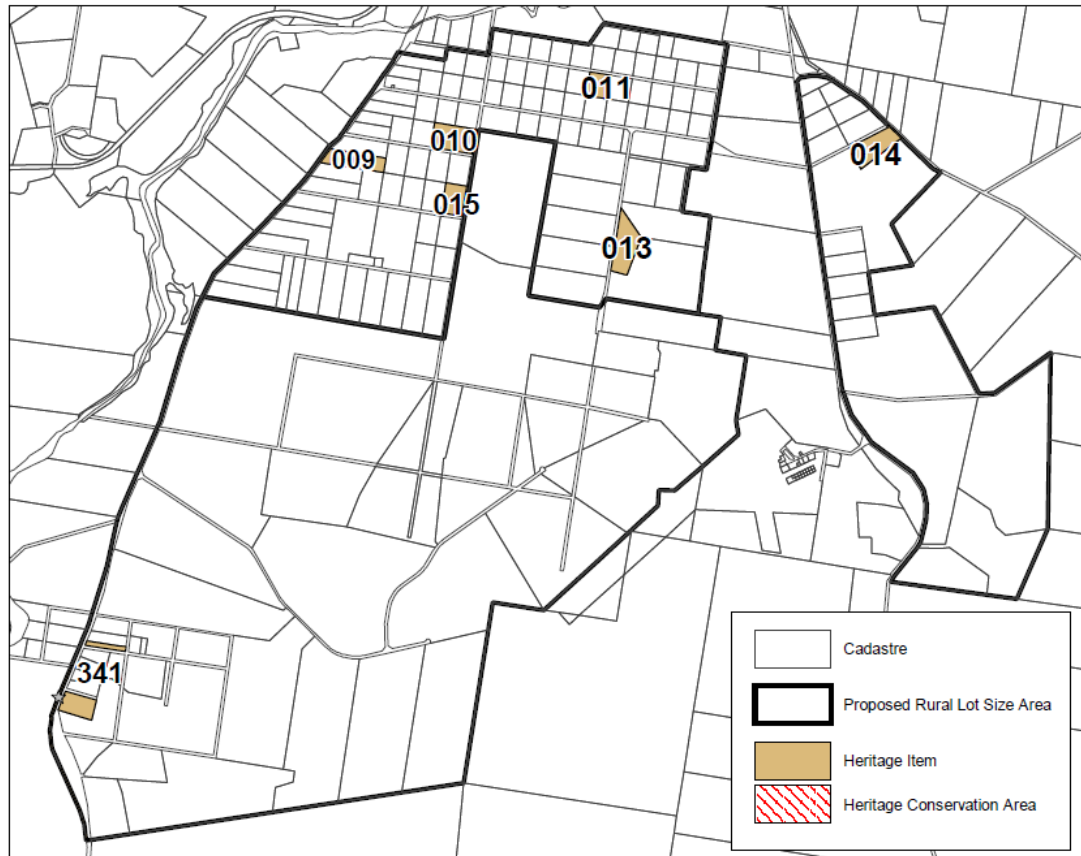
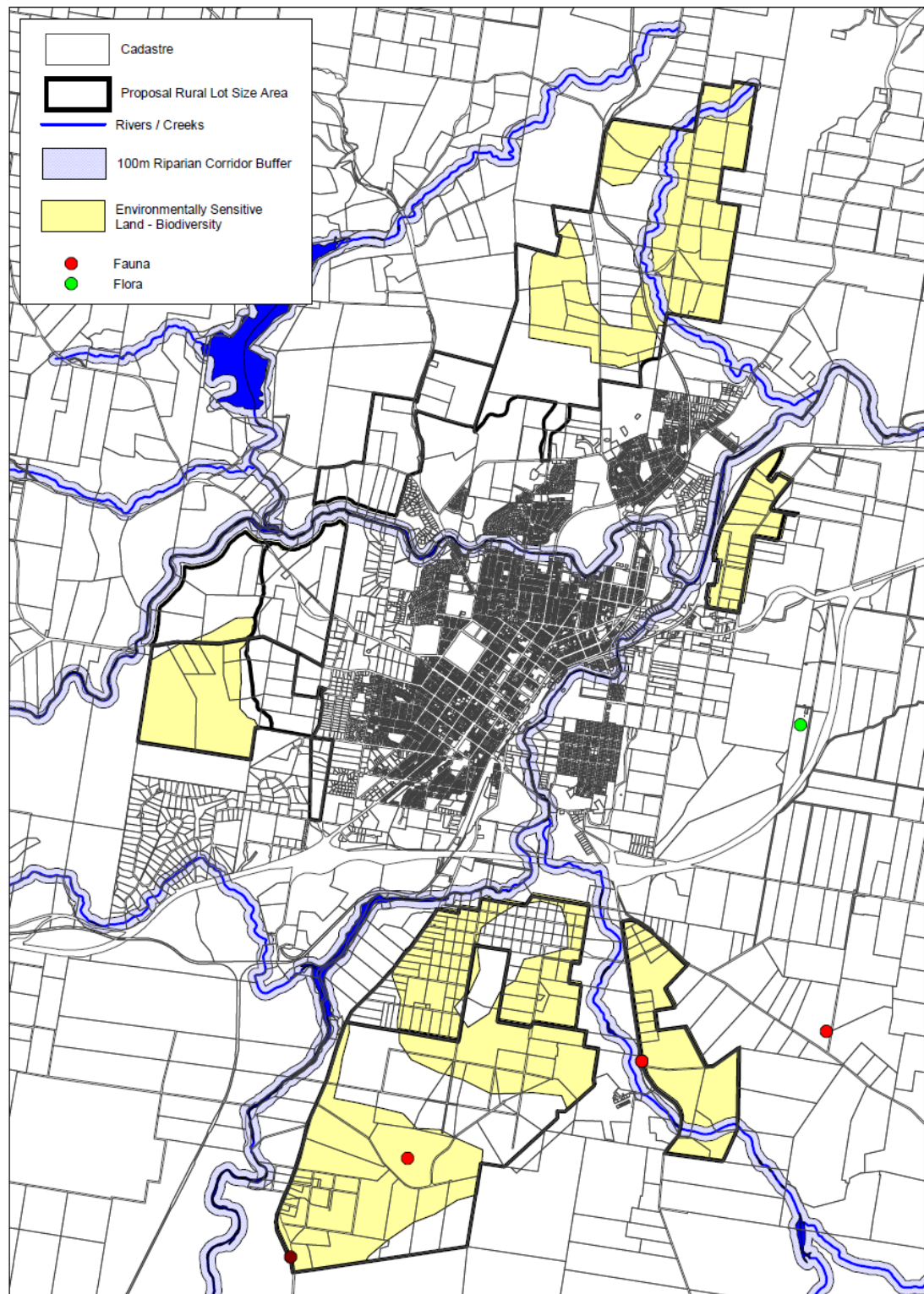


Figure 8.27 (D) Heritage Map - Goulburn

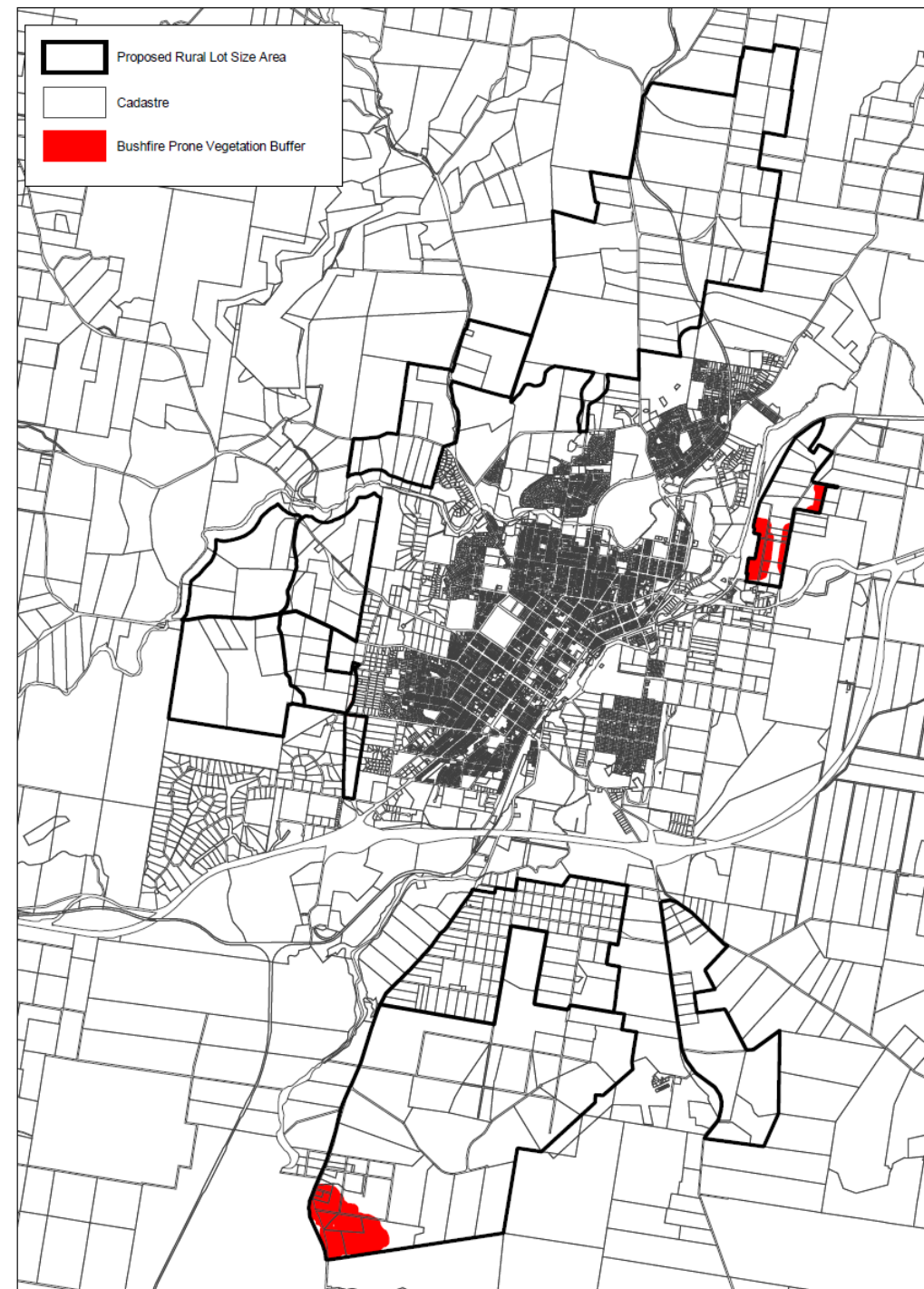
Figure 8.28 Constraints Mapping - Goulburn
