I refer to the subject planning proposal, which is seeking to rezone part of 251 Adelaide Street, Raymond Terrace, from RU2 Rural Landscape to R2 Low Density Residential.

The purpose of this email is to request an extension to the Gateway Determination timeframe for the planning proposal's completion to 31 December 2019.

The following steps have already been undertaken:

- Council resolution to prepare planning proposal 1 August 2017.
- Gateway determination 20 October 2017 (to be completed within 9 months).
- Additional studies November 2017 to April 2018.

- Referral to public authorities June to July 2018.
- Submission summary and updated referral comments provided to proponent 20 July 2018.
- Extension of Gateway Determination timeframe issued by Department 23 August 2018 (attached).

The following steps are proposed to complete the consideration of the planning proposal:

- Updated Planning Proposal submitted by Proponent Feb 2019.
- Updated referral to public authorities March 2019.
- Consideration post-exhibition (report to Council) May 2019.
- Anticipated date RPA will make the plan (if delegations remain) June/July 2019.
- Anticipated date RPA will forward the plan to the Department for notification (if delegations remain) August 2019.

Please note that, since the timeframe extension was granted on 23 August 2018, the proponent has been undertaking additional work to address the issues raised during exhibition and referral. In particular this includes odour modelling to address matters raised by Hunter Water Corporation. The proponent advises that a further odour assessment will be carried out tomorrow morning onsite, followed soon by an odour report for review by HWC.

Following the completion of all additional work, the proponent will be incorporating the results into an updated version of the planning proposal, and submitting to Council for final referral and assessment.
