	1. Prior to undertaking public exhibition, Council is to amend the planning proposal to remove the proposal to include 'signs on motor vehicles' within Schedule 2 Exempt Development because 'signs on motor vehicles' is controlled under other legislation.			
	2. Prior to undertaking public exhibition, Council is to update the planning proposal to include all relevant information consistent with the A Guide to Preparing Planning Proposals including a project timeline consistent with Section 2.6 Part 6.			
	3. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Environmenta Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") as follows:			
	(a) the planning proposal is classified as low impact as described in A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning & Infrastructure 2013) and must be made publicly available for a minimum of 14 days; and			
	(b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning & Infrastructure 2013).			
	4. Consultation is required with the Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) under section 56(2)(d) of the EP&A Act. RMS is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material, and given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal.			
	5. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).			
	6. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be 6 months from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.			
	Plan making delegation: The Minister delegated his plan making powers to councils in October 2012. Council has not requested to be issued with delegations for this planning proposal. Council should be issued with plan making delegation because the proposal is considered to be a
