Request to Notify Amendment No 14 to Yass Valley LEP 2013

I refer to the Gateway determination issued for the Planning Proposal PP_2020_YASSV_004_00 on 20 September 2020, which included delegation for local plan-making authority to the Yass Valley Council.

Council at its meeting of 16 December 2020 has resolved that:

- 1. The Planning Proposal 80 Murrumbateman Road, Murrumbateman (PP.2020.02) be adopted.
- 2. The opinion of the NSW Parliamentary Counsel's Office (PCO) be sought whether the amendment to the Yass Valley LEP 2013 can legally be made.
- 3. The amendment to the Yass Valley LEP 2013 be made as a local plan-making authority.
