I advise that on 13 May 2013, Council resolved to prepare a draft amendment to Lake Macquarie Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2004. The draft amendment aims to rezone the above land from 4(2) Industrial (General) to 3(1) Urban Centre.

I provide further detail of the proposal in the enclosed Council report and Planning Proposal, including a locality map showing the site, current zoning, aerial, proposed zoning, and surrounding area.

It is Council's opinion that a Local Environmental Study is not necessary due to the following:

- The site has been developed for industrial use and is devoid of vegetation. This site is within a well established urban area and is predominantly concrete hard stand. As a result, it is not considered any further biodiversity study is required on the site.
- The site is not affected by any issues relating to hydrology, water quality, or flooding.
- The site is not identified as bushfire prone land.
- The site does not contain, and is not within proximity to, any known heritage or Aboriginal heritage items.
- The site is currently serviced by all essential infrastructure including electricity, roads, water and sewer.

It is considered however, that traffic, contamination, visual impact, acoustic and geotechnical studies should be undertaken. This includes consultation with the Mine Subsidence Board, Roads and Maritime Services, Minerals DPI and Transport NSW.

Please forward the attached Planning Proposal and Council Report to the Gateway for determination.
