Subject: Land identified for acquisition by RMS in Lake Macquarie

Lake Macquarie City Council staff are reviewing land areas identified for acquisition under Lake Macquarie Local Environmental Plan (LM LEP) 2004 in the suburbs of Wyee, Morisset and Cooranbong. The purpose of the review is to ensure that LM LEP 2004 accurately identifies land areas required for acquisition.
