Upper Lachlan Local Environmental Plan 2010 – Request for rezoning of land to Zone E1 National Parks and Nature Reserves

Council has received Notices of Reservation from the NSW National Parks and Wildlife Service (Department of Environment and Climate Change NSW) regarding Keverstone National Park, Keverstone State Conservation Area and Mares Forest National Park.

Given that the land is reserved as National Park and is therefore vested in the Crown, Council is requesting an amendment to the *Upper Lachlan Local Environment Plan 2010* to rezone the land to Zone E1 National Parks and Nature Reserves.

In this regard, it is requested that the conditions precedent to Division 3, Part 4 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*, as it relates to the making of the amending local environmental plan (that is, planning proposal, gateway determination etc.), be dispensed with by virtue of Section 73A of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

Keverstone

The land affected by the Notice of Reservation for Keverstone is currently part Zone RU3 Forestry and part Zone E1 National Parks and Nature Reserves. Only the land within Zone RU3 is affected by this request. Lots 143 and 144, DP 724520 and Lot 1, DP 724521 are currently within Zone E1 National Parks and Nature Reserves.

The land subject to a request to rezone from Zone RU3 to Zone E1 and amend the Minimum Lot Size from AE 200 hectares to white (unspecified) is as follows:

- Keverstone National Park Lot 121, DP 753014 and part Lot 55, DP 753014.
- Keverstone State Conservation Area Lot 44, DP 753014 and part Lot 55, DP 753014

Mares Forest

The land affected by the Notice of Reservation for Mares Forest is currently part Zone RU2 Rural Landscape and part Zone E1 National Parks and Nature Reserves. Lots 4 and 27, DP 757071, Lots 33, 34, 101, 116, 117, 132, DP 757044, Lots 7002 and 7300 are currently within Zone E1 National Parks and Nature Reserves.

The land subject to a request to rezone from Zone RU2 to Zone E1 and amend the Minimum Lot Size from AE 200 hectares to white (unspecified) is as follows:

 Lots 87, 88, 100, 112, 113, 121, 122, 133, 135 and 140, DP 757044 and that part of the bed of Mares Forest Creek separating Lots 121, 122 and 115 from Lots 113, 112, 115 and 133, DP 757044.

Request for amendment

Council is seeking the Department's support for the amendment of Upper Lachlan Local Environmental Plan 2010 to provide for a consistency between the zoning and minimum lot size of the subject land with the gazetted Notices of Reservation for Keverstone and Mares Forest. The subject land is reserved as National Park, vested in the Crown and the request is an administrative process to ensure the appropriate zone and minimum lot size is applied.

As mentioned above, it is requested that the conditions precedent to Division 3, Part 4 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*, as it relates to the making of the amending local environmental plan (that is, planning proposal, gateway determination etc.), be dispensed with by virtue of Section 73A of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.
