	The rezoning will permit hospitals with development consent in the R2 Low Density Residential zone.

	Hospital permissibility and distribution is not a matter for the LHRS, however the
	amendment is consistent with the objectives and outcomes of the LHRS.
	Consultation
	Consultation The Planning Proposal was exhibited for a total of 14 days in accordance with the
	Gateway Determination from 22 July to 5 August 2013. One submission was
	received which contained a petition of 7 signatures.
	The petition objected to the proposal based on an incorrect assumption that the
	PP would rezone the Newcastle Eye Hospital. This is not the case as the PP
	seeks to allow hospitals in the R2 zone.
	The submission raised concerns that the proposal would place undue pressure
	on residential land and result in the loss of residential land. The PP will however
	allow an existing hospital to expand the impacts of which will be managed under
	Council's DCP controls. It is unlikely that Newcastle will experience a significant
	increase in development applications for hospitals as residential land values are
	prohibitive to developers requiring large site areas.
	In addition, the Director General has agreed to the inconsistency with Direction
	3.1 Residential zones as the potential impacts to residential land are considered
	of minor significance. This is because permitting 'hospital' in the R2 zone does
	not contain provisions that will reduce the permissible residential density of land,
	but it will enable an additional non-residential use within the R2 zone. It is
	acknowledged that this may result in a minor reduction of future housing stock,
	and is considered of minor significance.
	The submission also objected to traffic and amenity impacts on residential land.
	These potential impacts can be managed under a future development application.
	Consultation with Public Authorities
	No consultation with public authorities was required through the Gateway.
	S117 Directions
	The Director General's delegate agreed to the minor inconsistency with Direction
	The Director General's delegate agreed to the minor inconsistency with Direction 3.1 Residential Zones as part of the Gateway determination. The Planning
	Proposal is consistent with all other Ministers S117 Directions and State policies.
	Council was consulted in accordance with s59(1) and accepted the drafting of the
	instrument.
	Finalisation of the planning proposal has been delayed due to time taken to
	obtain a final PC Opinion and mapping issues. The PC Opinion was issued on 7
	March 2014 Tag PC Opinion.
