Council resolved at their meeting on the 28 September 2015 to support the preparation and lodgement of a Planning Proposal to the Department of Planning & Infrastructure seeking the reclassification and rezoning of the Council owned land which is now residue land from the Lake Macquarie Transport Interchange located at Glendale/Cardiff.

The attached Planning Proposal has been prepared in accordance with this resolution, section 55 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* and the format specified within the relevant Department of Planning Guidelines including 'A Guide to Preparing Local Environmental Plans' and 'A Guide to Preparing Planning Proposals'.
