Planning proposal to amend Bega Valley Local Environmental Plan 2013.

I am writing in response to your Council's letter dated 13 October requesting a Gateway determination under section 56 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act* 1979 (the Act) in respect of the planning proposal to rezone land at Cabarita Place Merimbula from R3 Medium Density Residential to B2 Local Centre to provide a Regional Learning Facility

As delegate of the Minister for Planning, I have now determined the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway determination.

I have also agreed the planning proposal's inconsistency with S117 Direction 3.1 Residential Zones, and 6.2 Reserving Land for Public Purposes is of minor significance. In relation to S117 Direction 6.2 Reserving Land for Public Purposes, I have agreed to the reduction/creation of land for public purposes on the basis that it will create a Regional Learning Centre in the Merimbula Town Centre. No further approval is required in relation to these Directions.

Plan making powers were delegated to councils by the Minister in October 2012. It is noted that Council has requested to be issued with delegation for this planning proposal. I have considered the nature of Council's planning proposal and have decided to issue an authorisation for Council to exercise delegation to make this plan.

The amending Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 18 months of the week following the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request to draft and finalise the LEP should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's Office 6 weeks prior to the projected publication date. A copy of the request should be forwarded to the Department of Planning and Environment for administrative purposes.

The State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under section 54(2)(d) of the Act if the time frames outlined in this determination are not met.

Gateway Determination

Planning proposal (Department Ref:PP_2015_BEGAV_008_00): to rezone land at Cabarita Place Merimbula from R3 Medium Density to B2 Local Centre to facilitate the provision of a Regional Learning Centre.

I, the Acting General Manager, Southern Region at the Department of Planning and Environment as delegate of the Minister for Planning, have determined under section 56(2) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* (the Act) that an amendment to the Bega Valley Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2013 to rezone land at Cabarita Place Merimbula from R3 Medium Density to B2 Local Centre to facilitate the provision of a Regional Learning Centre should proceed subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* as follows:
 - (a) the planning proposal must be made publicly available for a minimum of 28 days; and
 - (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of *A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning and Environment 2013)*.

No consultation is required with public authorities under section 56(2)(d) of the EP&A Act.

- A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).
- 3. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be **18 months** from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.
