Physical Description:	Former gasworks plant located in a gully on the west side of Shoalhaven Street. The plant comprised two loadbearing brick structures, the retort buildings and exhauster house, feeding via in ground pipes to a small gasometer close to the road. The gasometer has been removed but the circular foundation remains in place. The gabled brick structures are relatively intact, illustrating the industrial use of load bearing brickwork in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries.
