Assessment Criteria

Need for planning proposal :

This proposal arises from a comprehensive community consultation process and conservation study into the future management of the Waterfall General (Garrawarra) Cemetery.

A Conservation Management Plan has been prepared which identifies that the mapped boundary of the cemetery should be expanded to include additional curtilage.

The proposal will also expand the Conservation Area mapping to cover the area between Item 61028 (Cemetery) and Item 6486 (Hospital) to recognise the relationship between the two Items.

Council considered the option of combining the two Items into a single listing but felt that this would diminish the individual significance of each Item.

Council intends to seek a State Heritage Significance listing for the site - but that has not yet occurred and does not form part of this proposal.

Consistency with strategic planning framework:

This is a minor proposal that assists in preserving heritage by amending the LEP.

The proposal is consistent with Cultural Heritage Actions in the Illawarra Regional Strategy.

The proposal is consistent with Council's plan: Wollongong - 2022

Additional Information :

It is RECOMMENDED that the General Manager, Southern Region as delegate of the Minister for Planning, determine under section 56(2) of the EP&A Act that an amendment to the Wollongong Local Environmental Plan 2009 to: amend the listing of Item 61028 in

Schedule 5 - Environmental Heritage by changing the name of the Item to "Waterfall General (Garrawarra) Cemetery' and adding Lot 3 DP 840501 and Lot 622 DP 752033 to the property description of that Item; amend the Heritage Map to reflect the change in property description; and amend the Heritage Map to expand the area covered by the 'Garrawarra Hospital Heritage Conservation Area', should proceed subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") as follows:
- (a) the planning proposal is to be made publicly available for 14 days; and
 (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of A Guide to Preparing local environmental plans (Department of Planning and Infrastructure 2013).
- 2. Consultation is required with the following public authorities under section 56(2)(d) of the EP&A Act:
- * NSW Rural Fire Service
- * NSW Health
- * Crown Lands
- * Office of Environment and Heritage
- * Sydney Catchment Authority

Public authorities are to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material and given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal, or to indicate that it will require additional time to comment on the proposal. Note that consultation with the NSW Rural Fire Service is required prior to undertaking community consultation in order to satisfy the requirements of s117 Direction 4.4 Planning for Bushfire Protection.

- 3. No public hearing is required to be held into the matter under section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).
- 4. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be 9 months from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.

- 5. The Secretary's delegate can be satisfied that the planning proposal will be consistent with s117 Direction 4.4 Planning for Bushfire Protection following consultation with the NSW Rural Fire Service.
- 6. The Secretary's delegate can be satisfied that the planning proposal is consistent with other relevant s117 Directions, or that any inconsistencies are of minor significance.
