Planning proposal to amend Queanbeyan Local Environmental Plan 2012

I am writing in response to your Council's letter dated 7 July 2016 requesting a Gateway determination under section 56 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act* 1979 (the Act) in respect of the planning proposal to reclassify 5 sites from Community Land to Operational Land.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning, I have now determined the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway determination.

Plan making powers were delegated to councils by the Minister in October 2012. It is noted that Council has requested to be issued with delegation for this planning proposal. I have considered the nature of Council's planning proposal and have decided not to issue an authorisation for Council to exercise delegation to make this plan.

The amending Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 12 months of the week following the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request for the Department of Planning and Environment to draft and finalise the LEP should be made 6 weeks prior to the projected publication date.

The State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under section 54(2)(d) of the Act if the time frames outlined in this determination are not met.

Gateway Determination

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP_2016_QPREG_001_00): to reclassify 5 sites from Community Land to Operational Land.

I, the Acting Director Regions, Southern at the Department of Planning and Environment as delegate of the Minister for Planning, have determined under section 56(2) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 (the Act) that an amendment to the Queanbeyan Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2012 to reclassify the 5 sites below from Community Land to Operational Land (no interests changed) should proceed subject to the following conditions:

- Site 1. 4 Gregg Place Crestwood (Lot 64 DP 1150423),
- Site 2, 17 Dunn Street Queanbevan West (Lot 52 DP 262335).
- Site 3. 2 Faunce Street Queanbeyan East (Lot 24 DP 241159),
- Site 4. 500 Trig Lane Carwoola (Lot 6 DP 270584), and
- Site 5. 6655 Kings Highway Carwoola (Lot 7 DP 270584)
- 1.. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 as follows:
 - (a) the planning proposal must be made publicly available for a minimum of 28 days;
 - (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning and Environment 2013).
- 2. No consultation is required with public authorities under section 56(2)(d) of the EP&A Act
- 3. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).
- 4. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be 12 months from the date of the Gateway determination.
