LEP Amendment - Planning Proposal

Enable community title subdivision of approved Multiple Occupancy developments **Permit Community Title Subdivision** -

I refer to your correspondence regarding the above proposal which was received by the NSW Rural Fire Service on 27/05/2021.

The NSW RFS has considered the information submitted and provides the following comments.

The proposal is to permit the community title subdivision of existing approved MO residential developments. The majority of these developments are on mapped bush fire prone lands. Applications for Community Title subdivision should include

- Details of development consent;
- Compliance with that development consent including any bush fire requirements;
- Community Title plan to ensure each Community Titled lot has sufficient area to apply and existing bush fire requirements;
- Community Title statement to deal with the community title lot;
- Better bush fire outcomes.

The NSW RFS has no objection to the planning proposal and advices that future subdivision is to comply with the requirements of Planning for Bush fire Protection guidelines.
