Inner West Local Environmental Plan 2022 (Amendment No. 2)

I refer to the proposal to amend the Inner West Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2022 to facilitate a mixed use residential development at 58-76 Stanmore Road, 2-20 Tupper Street and 3-9 Alma Avenue, Stanmore.

I am advising that as the Minister for Planning and Public Space's delegate, I have made the plan under section 3.36(2)(a) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*, and under section 3.24(5) it will take effect when published on the NSW Legislation website.

Note that I have not supported some of Council's post-exhibition changes based on the detailed reasons and assessment in the Department's finalisation assessment report. While this is the case, the resulting LEP provisions including the requirement for a Development Control Plan (DCP) will enable a good development outcome for the site that fully aligns with the intensions for the proposal and that is suitable for the site's surrounds.

I would like to thank Council staff for their collaboration, diligence and expertise in assisting the Department to finalise this planning proposal. We look forward to continuing this approach.
