Under the Draft Planning Proposal (Stage 2), there are no proposed changes to the current Fairfield LEP Clause (below) applying to Canley Vale Town Centre.

7.5 Canley Vale—height of buildings

- (1) The objective of this clause is to allow development to be built to the maximum permissible building height if certain development standards are met.
- (2) This clause has effect despite clause 4.3.
- (3) The height of a building on land identified as "Canley Vale" on the Town Centre Precinct Map must not exceed 9 metres unless the site area of the building is to be at least the minimum site area shown for the land on the Minimum Site Area Map.
