This Bush Fire Emergency Management and Evacuation Plan is for Willinga Park and has been designed to assist management to protect life and property in the event of a bush fire. Always follow the directions of Willinga Park Park Emergency Coordinator and Emergency Service responders.



# **Bushfire response triggers and actions**

When a bushfire <u>EMERGENCY WARNING</u> is issued, and/or a bushfire is less than 2 hours from Willinga Park:

### **Implement Shelter-in-Place Response**

It is safest for all people to shelter-in-place in designated Emergency Assembly Areas at Willinga Park.

## **Shelter-in-Place Actions**

#### Visitors and staff

- Proceed on foot directly to Emergency Assembly Areas EA3 (Covered Arena) or EA2 (Mares Paddock)
- Follow all directions from the Willinga Park Emergency Chief Warden (via announcements made over the PA system) and emergency service responders

When a bushfire ADVICE or WATCH AND ACT WARNING is issued for Willinga Park; and/or a bushfire is more than 2 hours from WP:

In consultation with Emergency Services, Willinga Park's Emergency Chief Warden will advise if Early Off-Site Evacuation is required. When required, the following early evacuation response actions will be implemented:

## **Early Off-Site Evacuation Actions**

- Only undertake Early Off-Site Evacuation in accordance with directions of the Willinga Park Emergency Chief Warden;
- When departing Willinga Park by vehicle, follow all directions from WP staff coordinating vehicle movements from the property;
- Tune car radios to ABC Local Radio South East 103.5 FM (or ABC Illawara 97.3 FM) and listen for bushfire updates Act on Advice.
- Traffic control may be in place on public roads follow Emergency Service advice and directions.

- Provide assistance to less able visitors if needed
- Do not attempt to move vehicles or leave the site
- Advise relatives by SMS/Text of your situation
- Remain in place at the Emergency Assembly Area and follow further advice from the Emergency Chief Warden

#### Horse and livestock management

- At dressage and show jumping events, horses will be kept in the yards adjacent to the cabins or the covered arena
- Horses held in the yards adjacent to the cabins may be loaded in to horse trailers when safe to do so (at direction of Chief Warden)
- Yarded horses in all other stockyards and paddocks to remain at those locations – horses may only be moved if safe to do so (at the direction of the Emergency Chief Warden)
- Horses eventing in the arenas to be secured in paddocks adjacent to Emergency Assembly Area EA3 or EA2 (Mares Paddock)
- Horse owners to follow all directions from the Willinga Park Emergency Chief Warden

#### Horse and livestock management

- At Campdrafting events cattle will be kept in paddocks adjacent to the Campdraft arena
- Horses held in the Covered Stockyards may be loaded in to horse trailers when safe to do so (at direction of Chief Warden)
- Yarded horses in all other stockyards and paddocks to remain at those locations – horses may only be moved if safe to do so (at the direction of the Emergency Chief Warden)
- Horses eventing on the polocrosse field to be secured in paddocks adjacent to Emergency Assembly Area EA2 (Mares Paddock)
- Horse owners to follow all directions from the Willinga Park Emergency Chief Warden
