Planning proposal PP-2021-3724 to amend Bellingen Local Environmental Plan 2010

I am writing in response to Council's request for a Gateway determination under section 3.34(1) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* (the Act) in respect of the planning proposal to rezone Lot 456 DP 755557, Endeavour Drive, Bellingen from RU1 to E3 and E4 and permit Community Title subdivision on the land zoned E4.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning and Public Spaces, I have now determined that the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the enclosed Gateway determination.

I have also agreed, as delegate of the Secretary, the planning proposal's inconsistencies with section 9.1 Directions 1.5 Rural Lands, 2.1 Environment Protection Zones, 2.3 Heritage Conservation, 2.6 Remediation of Contaminated Land, 4.1 Acid Sulfate Soils, 4.3 flood Prone Land, 5.10 Implementation of Regional Plans and 6.3 Site Specific Provisions are justified in accordance with the terms of the Direction. No further approval is required in relation to these Directions.

Council may still need to obtain the agreement of the Secretary to comply with the requirements of relevant section 9.1 Directions 4.4 Planning Bushfire Protection. Council should ensure this occurs prior to public exhibition / the plan being made.

I have considered Council's request to be the local plan-making authority and have determined not to condition the Gateway for Council to be the local plan-making authority for this proposal to align with the Minister for Planning and Public Spaces announcement to issue a new section 9.1 Direction which will allow only the Minister to rezone land from a rural zone to an environmental zone.

The amending local environmental plan (LEP) is to be finalised within nine months of the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request for the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment to draft and finalise the LEP should be made eight weeks prior to the projected publication date.

The state government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under section 3.32(2)(d) of the Act if the time frames outlined in this determination are not met.
