	This Carpenter Gothic style timber church is historically significant in the development of the Torrington village settlement in the late 1920s and its community life. It holds aesthetic significance for its timber and iron vernacular traditional form and materials, bell and unusual plywood timber interior lining and moveable items. It is a small scale historical landmark building in the village. It demonstrates the evolution of community development in Torrington in the 1920s and confidence in the development of the settlement. It is socially significant to the community as a place of past, present and future events, including services and fellowship, baptism, weddings and funerals.

Historical notes An extensive history of Torrington is outlined in the publication 'Old Torrington' compiled by the residents of the village of Torrington in 1981 and updated in 2017. The following information is summarised for contextual history. Torrington is a settlement which was historically developed for its mining interests and in particular tin and tungsten mining with some of the significant mines being the Torrington, Dutchman, Wallaroo, Curnows and Butlers. Sherratts Battery and Buddle is still in existence.

A prospector Joe Bates first struck the big lode in 1881 and called it Torrington, a name derived from Great Torrington in Devonshire. This holds connection to the mining places of Cornwall and Devon. The village at this time only consisted of bark and corrugated iron houses. By 1883 small prospectors had lost control to overseas mining companies. A school and post office were established. The name 'Torrington' was adopted in 1883, and there has been great discussion about the spelling. on 21 May 1970, the spelling Torrington was adopted by the Post Office. In 1907 an area was reserved for village purposes but in reality it has been a village settlement.

By the peak of the 1920s, 500 men were employed at the mines and there were sixteen batteries working in the area. Torrington supported five general stores, two cafes, a bakery, two billiard rooms, a Police Station, two garages, a school with over 100 children, Post Office, two churches, the hotel, a hall/picture theatre, lodges, several tennis courts, sporting facilities, a rifle range and a race course.

By the end of World War II, the tin subsidy provided by the Government was dropped and the major mines closed and Torrington never recovered. However there is still interest in mining and options taken by companies. Mining has given way to fossicking and tourism. Visitors are drawn by the scenery of rocky granite outcrops and fossick for topaz, quartz and the many minerals found in the area. Unfortunately the last general store were closed some years ago.

THIS ITEM

The All Saints Church (Church of England) now Anglican was built in 1927 and dedicated on 26 June 1927. The windows were donated by 'The Children of Torrington'.

Early Reverends included George Huntley Rae, F. Wilde and Frank Young. Those who followed included Harold Doyle, EF North, W McLeod, and Cpt Les Fernance and Max Hull who left the parish in 1980. The church is still in use in a limited capacity although it lacks electricity or water connections. The church is one of two built in Torrington the other being Our Lady Help of Christians Roman Catholic Church which no longer has a congregation.
