Re: Planning Proposal to provide a land release extension to the Harrington Urban Area

I am writing in response to your Council's letter dated 10 May 2010 requesting a Gateway Determination under section 56 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") in respect of the planning proposal to amend the Greater Taree Local Environmental Plan 2010 to provide a land release extension to the existing Harrington Urban Area.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning, I have now determined that the planning proposal should not proceed for the reasons outlined in the attached Gateway Determination.

It is considered that the proposal to release land in this area should await the completion of the updated flood modelling at present being carried out by Council. The findings of this study will allow Council to justify any inconsistencies with the s117 Direction 4.3 Flood Prone Land.
