The LEP Amendment now proposed by Council under Section 73A of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act, 1979 seeks to correct this mapping error. Need for planning proposal :	As Council states, the proposed LEP Amendment would correct an obvious map error and is of minor nature. s73A(1)(b) of the Act provides that it may be used where an LEP Amendment would "address matters in the principal instrument that are of a consequential, transitional, machinery or other minor nature". As the error inadvertently resulted from a subsequent LEP amendment that was undertaken relatively recently, the Department is satisfied that this may be considered to be of "other minor nature" and so s73A may be used.

	3. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in respon a submission or if reclassifying land).			
	4. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be 3 months from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.
