REQUEST FOR A S73A AMENDMENT - NEWCASTLE LOCAL ENVIRONMENTAL PLAN 2012

Newcastle City Council requests an amendment to the Newcastle Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2012 under Section 73A of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979. The amendment is to correct a formatting error of a land use term within the land use table.

The land use table for the IN3 Heavy Industrial zone incorrectly lists an undefined land use - "*Recreation <u>areas</u> (indoor)*" as permitted with consent. This term is not defined in the standard instrument and is not used elsewhere in the LEP.

I have reviewed the land use matrix that was exhibited with the LEP and the final land use matrix (copy attached) and note that the defined land use term "*Recreation facility (indoor*)" is shown as permitted with consent in the IN3 Heavy Industrial Zone. However, all draft versions of the written instrument contain the words "*Recreation areas (indoor*)". No changes were made to the land use table for the IN3 zone between exhibition and adoption of the LEP.

Council is satisfied that the term '*Recreation areas (indoor*)' is a formatting error and that it was intended to include the defined land use term '*Recreation facility (indoor*)' as permissible with consent in the IN3 Heavy Industrial Zone. As such, we request that the Department progress this matter under Section 73A.
