Following the amendments to the Tweed LEP 2014 arising from the State Environmental Planning Policy Amendment (Tweed Valley Hospital) 2019 (made 22 February 2019) and the subsequent Tweed LEP 2014, Amendment No 27, made 7 February 2020 a number of mapping anomalies remain to the mapping sheet 23
