

Gateway Determination

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP – 2021 - 4816): to amend the clause 1.9A of Wingecarribee Local Environmental Plan 2010 to enable the legal enforcement of Purchaser's Agreements (and associated Design Guidelines) for purchasers of land lots within the West Retford Park residential estate.

I, the Director, Southern Region, at the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment, as delegate of the Minister for Planning and Public Spaces, have determined under section 3.34(2) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* (the Act) that an amendment to the Wingecarribee Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2010 as described above should proceed subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Prior to public exhibition, the planning proposal shall be updated to include Draft Local Clauses Map/s in the event the option of a local clause is utilised to achieve the intended effects.
- 2. Public exhibition is required under section 3.34(2)(c) and schedule 1 clause 4 of the Act as follows:
 - (a) the planning proposal must be made publicly available for a minimum of **28 days**; and
 - (b) the planning proposal authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 6.5.2 of *A guide to preparing local environmental plans* (Department of Planning and Environment, 2018).
- 3. Consultation is required with the following public authorities/organisations under section 3.34(2)(d) of the Act and/or to comply with the requirements of relevant section 9.1 Directions:
 - WaterNSW: and
 - NSW Rural Fire Service.

Each public authority/organisation is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material and given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal.

4. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 3.34(2)(e) of the Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).

5. The time frame for completing the LEP is to be **12 months** following the date of the Gateway determination expiring on 16 August 2022.
