Notice is hereby given under Section 3.34(2)(c) and Schedule 1 Clause 4 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act* 1979 for a Planning Proposal (PP-2021-6050) to amend the Wakool Local Environmental Plan 2013. The Proposal seeks to reclassify Council owned land at Lot 1 DP1267277, Gonn Road, Barham from 'community land' to 'operational land'.

A Public Hearing will be held on **Thursday 3rd February 2022** regarding the proposed reclassification of this site. The Hearing will be held from 6pm in the Barham Riverside Reception Centre, 15 Murray Street, Barham. At this stage, Council do not anticipate registration will be required to attend the Hearing, however this is subject to change dependent on NSW Public Health Orders.
