Planning Proposal PP-2021-6839 to amend Cumberland Local Environmental Plan 2021 (Victor Brazier Park)

I am writing in response to Council's request for a Gateway determination under section 3.34(1) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 (the Act), and additional information received on 10 November 2021, for the planning proposal to reclassify Council owned land from 'community' to 'operational', rezone and amend development controls for a portion of Victor Brazier Park, Guildford.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning, I have determined that the planning proposal should not proceed. The planning proposal has not demonstrated strategic or site specific merit or consistency with the relevant priorities, aims or objectives of various State and local planning strategies.

The planning proposal is inconsistent with the key aims of relevant strategies and direction to maintain and enhance open space and green cover available in an area that is planned for growth.

The planning proposal does not provide adequate justification and evidence that the proposed reclassification and development control amendments will achieve the objectives of addressing community concerns about anti-social and illegal behaviour in Victor Brazier Park.
