

Gateway Determination

Planning Proposal (Department Ref: PP_CESSN_2017_003_00): Correction of heritage-related errors and inconsistencies.

I, the Director Regions, Hunter, at the Department of Planning and Environment as delegate of the Minister for Planning, have determined under section 73A of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act, 1979* (the Act) that an amendment to the Cessnock Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2011 to correct heritage-related errors and inconsistencies in Schedule 5 and heritage maps should proceed subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Exclude the change relating to Item 216 Great Northern Railway Network.
- 2. Exclude the change that would combine Item 74 with Item 75.
- 3. No community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Act.
- 4. No consultation is required with public authorities/organisation under section 56(2)(d) of the Act.
- 5. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the Act.
- 6. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be **3 months** following the date of the Gateway determination.
