Planning proposal PP-2021-6934 to amend Georges River Local Environmental Plan 2021

I am writing in response to Council's request for a Gateway determination under section 3.34(1) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* (the Act) in respect of the planning proposal to rezone land at 143-149 Boundary Road & 689-691 Forest Road, Peakhurst from R2 Low Density Residential to B1 Neighbourhood Centre, increase height of buildings to part 12m, part 15m, increase floor space ratio to part 1.5:1, part 1.7:1 and remove minimum lot size and minimum lot size for dual occupancies on all sites.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning, I have determined that the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the enclosed Gateway determination.

Please note that conditions of Gateway have been included requiring the planning proposal to be updated prior to submitting the planning proposal for finalisation. These amendments are not required to be sent to the Department prior to community consultation.

I also note that Council has requested to be authorised as the local plan-making authority. I have determined to authorise Council to be the local plan-making authority in this instance, as the proposal is of local significance.

The amending local environmental plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 9 months of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request to draft and finalise the LEP should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's Office six weeks prior to the projected publication date. A copy of the request should be forwarded to the Department of Planning and Environment.

The NSW Government has committed to reduce the time taken to complete LEPs. To meet these commitments, the Minister may appoint an alternate planning proposal authority if Council does not meet the timeframes outlined in the gateway determination.

The Department's categorisation of planning proposals in the Local Environmental Plan Making Guideline (Department of Planning, Industry and Environment, 2021) is supported by category specific timeframes for satisfaction of conditions and authority and Government agency referrals, consultation, and responses. Compliance with milestones will be monitored by the Department to ensure planning proposals are progressing as required.
