EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

It is over 12 months since the Maitland Local Environmental Plan 2011 (MLEP 2011) became operational, and since its inception several minor anomalies have been noted (see **Attachment 1 – Planning Proposal**). A draft Local Environmental Plan (LEP) has been prepared, known as the Housekeeping LEP 2012, to rectify the noted anomalies contained within the current MLEP 2011. The purpose of this report is to propose that the planning proposal be submitted to the Department of Planning & Infrastructure so that a Gateway Determination can be issued, which will permit the planning proposal to be exhibited.
