## RE: Planning proposal PP-2021-7085 to amend Wakool Local Environmental Plan 2013 Cygnet Lane, Murray Downs

Thank you for the Gateway Determination issued in respect to Planning Proposal PP-2021-7085. Please find attached the response to Item 1(a)-(c) as requested. The response has been provided in the form of an Addendum to be read in conjunction with the original Planning Proposal submission. We await your advice that the Planning Proposal is approved to progress to public consultation.

It is noted Council have not had capacity to complete the response within the timeframe stipulated within the original PP. This is due to a number of reasons, including that Council's three Senior Town Planners have each completed a four-month secondment over the last 12 months, which has significantly reduced the capacity of Council to complete Planning Proposals within the requested timeframe. Council has also seen a significant increase in workload of the last 12 months, including the number of Development Applications received (in excess of 600 for the 2021/22 Financial Year), in excess of 1060 Planning Certificates for the 2021/22 Financial Year, in excess of 40 new town planning enquiries per week, and a significant number of complex Subdivision Works Certificates and Subdivision Certificates due to the growth of Moama. Further to the above, Council over the last 12 months have seen a number of town planning staff (including Strategic Planning, Town Planner, and Cadet Town Planner) depart and unfortunately have been unable to backfill such positions.

As such, we hereby request an extension of time to complete this Planning Proposal, in accordance with the attached revised Project Plan timeline. We believe this extended timeline provides a realistic period to complete to adoption, based on Council resourcing, and completing strategic projects currently being undertaken by Council. We would also be very grateful for the opportunity to harness the NSW DPE 'Surge Team' for the completion of the final stages of this proposal, if possible.
