	2. Community consultation: (a)should be undertaken for a minimum of 28 days under section 56(2) of the EP&A Act; (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of 'A Guide to preparing local environmental plans' for proponents and councils (Department of Planning and Infrastructure April 2013).
	 Consultation should be undertaken with: NSW Office of Environment & Heritage (proposal and studies); Transport for NSW (proposal and studies); NSW Rural Fire Service (s117 Direction 4.4 Planning for Bushfire Protection); ACT Government (in respect of any cross-border planning matters).

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	Each public authority is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any
	relevant supporting material. Each public authority is to be given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal, or to indicate that it will require additional time to comment on the proposal. Public authorities may request additional information or additional matters to be addressed in the planning proposal.
	4. No public hearing is required to be held into the matter under section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing.
	5. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be 24 months from the week following the date of the Gateway Determination.
	6. Council has provided a timeframe that suggests 12 months for completion but does not detail key milestones. A more detailed timeline is required identifying key milestones, including the commissioning and completion of necessary studies, that is achievable within the 24 month time frame.
	6. Council be authorised to use the Minister's plan making delegation under sections 59(2),(3)&(4) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979.
	 7.
