As you are aware, the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure delegated his plan making powers to councils in October 2012. It is noted that Council has now accepted this delegation.

In light of this delegation, I have considered the nature of various planning proposals which are yet to be finalised and have decided to issue Council with authorisation to exercise its delegation for the making of the below proposals. Council is reminded that it must not use its delegation where there is an unresolved agency objection to the proposal. If an agency objects to the proposal, Council is to contact the regional office of the department to seek assistance in resolving the matter so that the planning proposal may proceed under delegation.


Council is also reminded that it may still need to obtain the Director General's agreement to satisfy the requirements of relevant S117 Directions. Council should ensure this occurs prior to the plan being made.

The planning proposals should still be finalised within the timeframes identified in the Gateway determination. Council's request to draft and finalise the plans should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's Office as soon as possible to ensure timeframes are met. Council should consult the Parliamentary Counsel's website (www.pco.nsw.gov.au) to ensure all necessary information is provided in its request to draft the plan.

A copy of the request should also be forwarded to the department for administrative purposes (planmaking.monitoring@planning.nsw.gov.au). If Council requires any assistance, including assistance with access to GIS support or liaison with Parliamentary Counsel's Office on the drafting of the plan it should contact the regional office. 
WRITTEN AUTHORISATION TO EXERCISE DELEGATION
