Assessment Criteria

Need for planning
proposal :Mapping inconsistencies were noted between the current Flood Planning Maps in the
Maitland Local Environmental Plan 2011 and information from the 'Hunter River: Branxton
to Green Rocks Flood Study 2010'.

The current Flood Planning Maps contained in the Maitland Local Environmental Plan 2011 reflect outdated flood mapping from before the Flood Study 2010 was adopted by Council.

The New South Wales Floodplain Development Manual 2005 identifies the need for local Councils to"...Incorporate appropriate planning provisions of Floodplain Risk Management Plans into Local Environmental Plans, Development Control Plans and development control policies." (Floodplain Development Manual 2005:11).

While the Draft Floodplain Risk Managenment Plan has not yet been adopted by Council, the flood study, Hunter River: Branxton to Green Rocks Flood Study 2010 was adopted by Council on 27 July 2010. The action to update the Maitland Local Environmental Plan 2011 Flood Planning Maps is seen to be consistent with the Floodplain Development Manual 2005 and the adopted 2010 Flood Study.

This broader context and the flood study should be exhibited with the proposal to demonstrate the need for the proposal and justify its scope.

Consistency with strategic planning framework :

Lower Hunter Regional Strategy, 2006

Page 38 of the Lower Hunter Regional Strategy discusses the issue of flooding as a natural hazard, most relevantly:

'Appropriate planning provisions will be incorporated in Local Environmental Plans consistent with the Floodplain Development Manual and Council's risk management plan to minimise risk from flooding.' (Lower Hunter Regional Strategy, 2006, 2006:38); and

'Local Environmental Plans will zone areas subject to high hazard to reflect the limitations of the land.' (Lower Hunter Regional Strategy, 2006:39).

The proposal is consistent with the Lower Hunter Regional Strategy, 2006.

State Environmental Planning Policy (Infrastructure) 2007

While some parts of this State Environmental Planning Policy relate to flooding, this planning proposal does not seek to change land uses within any zone covered by the Flood Planning Maps. However Public Authority infrastructure works otherwise exempt from development consent under this SEPP require notifictaion to council where they are located within flood liable land.

It would be appropriate therefore to advise Public Authority asset owners of changes in the flood liability status of their land, easements and assets.

The proposal will be consistent with State Environmental Planning Policy (Infrastructure) 2007.

STATE ENVIRONMENTAL PLANNING POLICY (INFRASTRUCTURE) 2007 - REG 15

Consultation with councils-development with impacts on flood liable land 15 Consultation with councils-development with impacts on flood liable land

(1) In this clause,

"flood liable land" means land that is susceptible to flooding by the probable maximum flood event, identified in accordance with the principles set out in the manual entitled Floodplain Development Manual: the management of flood liable land published by the New South Wales Government and as in force from time to time.

(2) A public authority, or a person acting on behalf of a public authority, must not carry out, on flood liable land, development that this Policy provides may be carried out without consent and that will change flood patterns other than to a minor extent unless the authority or person has:

(a) given written notice of the intention to carry out the development to the council for the
