Planning proposal to amend Gosford Local Environmental Plan 2014

I am writing in response to Council's letter dated 3 September 2014 requesting a Gateway determination under section 56 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") in respect of the planning proposal to add bulky goods premises and office premises, with a combined maximum floor area capped at 5,500m², as additional permitted uses at Lot 1 DP 862725, Pacific Highway, Lisarow.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning, I have now determined the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway determination.

I have also agreed the planning proposal's inconsistency with section 117 directions 1.1 Business and Industrial Zones, 5.1 Implementation of Regional Strategies and 6.3 Site Specific Provisions is justified. No further approval is required in relation to these directions.

Council may still need to obtain the agreement of the Department's Secretary to comply with the requirements of relevant section 117 directions. Council should ensure this occurs prior to the plan being made.

The Department encourages Council to undertake a strategic review of land use zonings and planning controls in and around Lisarow Village Centre, including Lisarow train station, and explore opportunities for better connectivity between the existing and future land uses in the vicinity. Council should consider scheduling such work in its forward strategic planning work program.

Plan making powers were delegated to councils by the Minister in October 2012. It is noted that Council has requested to be issued with delegation for this planning proposal. I have considered the nature of Council's planning proposal and have decided to issue an authorisation for Council to exercise delegation to make this plan.

The amending Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 9 months of the week following the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request to draft and finalise the LEP should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's Office 6 weeks prior to the projected publication date. A copy of the request should be forwarded to the Department of Planning and Environment for administrative purposes.

The State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under section 54(2)(d) of the EP&A Act if the time frames outlined in this determination are not met.

Gateway Determination

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP_2014_GOSFO_016_00): to permit development for bulky goods premises and office premises, with a combined maximum floor area capped at 5,500m², as additional permitted uses at Pacific Highway, Lisarow.

I, the General Manager, Hunter and Central Coast Region at the Department of Planning and Environment as delegate of the Minister for Planning, have determined under section 56(2) of the EP&A Act that an amendment to the Gosford Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2014 to add bulky goods premises and office premises, with a combined maximum floor area capped at 5,500m², as additional permitted uses at Lot 1 DP862725, Pacific Highway, Lisarow should proceed subject to the following conditions:

1. Council is to update the planning proposal to include sufficient additional information to adequately demonstrate consistency or justify any inconsistency with the S117 Directions 4.3 Flood Prone Land and 4.4 Planning for Bushfire Protection once it has undertaken consultation with the relevant public authority.
2. Council is to ensure that the planning proposal satisfies the requirements of State Environmental Planning Policy (SEPP) 55 – Remediation of Land. If required, Council is to prepare an initial site contamination investigation report to demonstrate that the site is suitable for rezoning to the proposed zone. This report is to be included as part of the public exhibition material.
3. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") as follows:
 - (a) the planning proposal must be made publicly available for a minimum of **14 days**; and
 - (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of *A guide to preparing Local Environmental Plans (Department of Planning and Infrastructure 2013)*.
4. Consultation is required with the following public authorities under section 56(2)(d) of the EP&A Act and/or to comply with the requirements of relevant section 117 directions:
 - NSW Rural Fire Service (S117 Direction 4.4 Planning for Bushfire Protection)
 - Transport for NSW - Roads and Maritime Services
 - Transport for NSW – Sydney Trains

Each public authority is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material, and given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal.

5. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).



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6. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be **9 months** from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.
