Planning proposal to amend Great Lakes Local Environmental Plan 2013

I am writing in response to your Council's letter dated 25 January 2016 requesting a Gateway determination under section 56 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") in respect of the planning proposal for a minor revision to the zoned route of The Southern Parkway Collector Road, South Forster.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning, I have now determined the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway determination.

In relation to S117 Direction 6.2 Reserving Land for Public Purposes, I have agreed to the reduction and creation of land for public purposes on the basis that the new transport route provides a better planning and environmental outcome. No further approval is required in relation to this Direction.

I have also agreed the planning proposal's inconsistencies with s117 direction 1.5 Rural Lands is of minor significance. No further approval is required in relation to this direction.

The amending Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 9 months of the week following the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request for the Department of Planning and Environment to draft and finalise the LEP should be made 6 weeks prior to the projected publication date.

The State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under section 54(2)(d) of the EP&A Act if the time frames outlined in this determination are not met.

Gateway Determination

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP_2016_GLAKE_0001): for a minor revision to the zoned route of The Southern Parkway Collector Road, South Forster.

I, the Director Regions, Hunter and Central Coast at Department of Planning and Environment as delegate of the Minister for Planning, have determined under section 56(2) of the EP&A Act that an amendment to the Great Lakes Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2013 for a minor revision to the zoned route of The Southern Parkway Collector Road, South Forster should proceed subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") as follows:
 - (a) the planning proposal is classified as low impact as described in *A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning & Environment 2013)* and must be made publicly available for a minimum of **14 days**; and
 - (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning & Environment 2013).
- 2. No consultation is required with public authorities under section 56(2)(d) of the EP&A Act.
- 3. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).
- 4. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be **9 months** from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.
