## Planning Proposal PP\_2011\_PORTS\_004\_00 – Gateway Determination Alteration

I refer to Council's request for an alteration to the Gateway Determination for the Planning Proposal PP\_2011\_PORTS\_004\_00 to rezone part of lots 412 DP 1063902 and 413 DP 1063902, Medowie Road, Medowie to facilitate urban development. R2 Low Density Residential, R5 Large Lot Residential, B2 Local Centre and RE1 Public Recreation.

I have determined as the delegate of the Minister, in accordance with section 56(7) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act, 1979, to amend the Gateway Determination dated 28 October 2011 for PP\_2011\_PORTS\_004\_00.

The Gateway Determination is amended such that part of lots 412 DP 1063902 and 413 DP 1063902 Medowie, would be rezoned from RU2 Rural Landscape and R5 Large Lot Residential, to R2 Low Density Residential and R5 Large Lot Residential only, in the Port Stephens Local Environmental Plan 2013.

In considering Council's request to alter the Gateway Determination, I note that Council does not intend to re-exhibit the planning proposal following this postexhibition change. This is a matter for Council to determine, after taking into consideration the scale of the change and need for community input.

I have also considered the nature of the planning proposal and decided to issue Council with authorisation to exercise its plan-making delegation.

Council is reminded that it may still need to obtain the Director General's agreement to satisfy the requirements of relevant S117 Directions. Council should ensure this occurs prior to the plan being made.

Council's request to draft and finalise the plans should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's Office as soon as possible, as the Planning Proposal will make a positive contribution to achieving the housing targets identified for Port Stephens in the Lower Hunter Regional Strategy. Council should consult the Parliamentary Counsel's website (www.pco.nsw.gov.au) to ensure all necessary information is provided in its request to draft the plan. A copy of the request should also be forwarded to the department for administrative purposes (planmaking.monitoring@planning.nsw.gov.au).
